Position Description

This position is responsible for the diagnosis, repair, maintenance and inspection of trucks and various utility related equipment. Work schedule is from Noon to 8:30 pm Monday-Thursday and Friday 6:00 am to 4:30 pm. Overtime is usually required (10 am – 8:30 pm) as well as every third Saturday for 4 hours. Starting pay over \$70,000.00

Essential Functions

- Diagnose and repair mobile hydraulic systems and related components
- Diesel and gasoline engine diagnosis and repair
- Drive line repairs
- Air, hydraulic, and electric brake diagnosis and repairs
- Welding, cutting and fabrication
- Perform annual/periodic inspections
- Troubleshoot and repair auxiliary electrical systems and components as needed
- Maintain close contact with internal customers to assess the effectiveness and quality of services provided
- Work evening shift and be available for day shift including occasional Saturdays to cover absences and heavy workloads

Knowledge/Education

- Experience in automotive/truck technology required; Graduate of post-secondary automotive/truck technology program preferred.
- Must have own tools.
- Ability to obtain ASE certification in heavy truck
- Experience in mobile hydraulic diagnosis and repair
- Class A preferred; minimum Class B acceptable with requirement to obtain Class A within one year of date of hire
